CAPE POINT VINEYARDS ISLIEDH 2013

BLEND: 82% Sauvignon Blanc, 18% Semillon
WINEMAKER: Duncan Savage
WINE DISTRICT: Cape Peninsula

WINEMAKING DATA: Grapes for this wine are picked on the picturesque south facing Noordhoek slopes from the Peninsulas' southern most vineyards. The grapes were harvested between 23°B and 25°B in the early hours of the morning and were all hand-picked.

VINEYARD

- Trellis: Vertical trellis
- Planting Density: 3200 vines/ha
- Soil: Decomposed granite
- Irrigation: Drip
- Yield: 3 tons/ha

CELLAR

- Skin: Contact none, whole bunch pressed
- Settling: 8 hours
- Yeast: Inoculated and spontaneous ferment
- Fermentation: 95% barrel (50% new)
- Fermentation Temperature: 5% amphora 18-20°C
- Lees Ageing: 10 months on gross lees. 10 months with regular mixing

ANALYSIS:

- Alcohol: 14%/Vol
- RS: 2.0 g/l
- pH: 3.3
- TA: 6.8g/l
- TSO₂: 112mg/l
- FSO₂: 35mg/l

WINEMAKER'S NOTES: Isliedh is enjoyment with great food which will reward for many years to come. The wine displays a complex array of Stone fruit, floral elements, limes, grapefruit and spicy oak. The palate is rich, seductive and exotic while still retaining the characteristic Cape Point mineral edge. The blend can be best enjoyed from late 2014 over the next 5 - 10 years. Pair with Fresh line fish, Crayfish, rich chicken dishes and even duck!
